From the Pastor's Pen

My First Prez Friends in Christ,

Saturday, February 8th Middle Tennessee Presbyterians will gather from east and west, north and south to meet at First Prez for the One Hundred Fifty-Ninth Stated Meeting of the Middle Tennessee Presbytery. Registration is from 8:00am to 8:30am. Promptly at 8:30am, the meeting shall be convened in the sanctuary. If you wish to attend the meeting itself, you may listen and share in the meeting, but without voice nor vote. You will have to register to do so. Otherwise, without registering, everyone is welcome to attend worship and a short fellowship to follow. A mammoth “THANK YOU” to elders Katherine Marsh and Lori Smith for planning, recruiting, and using their many gifts to prepare our church to host and to everyone who has volunteered to serve: to help park, welcome, participate in worship, set up, provide hospitality, and clean up before and afterwards. It is a huge service and blessing for our church to host our Presbytery of Middle Tennessee.

We are truly a Presbyterian church because we participate in the biblically based structure of government and ministry in our Presbyterian history from John Calvin to John Knox to John Witherspoon to George Newton to Robert Cogswell. We could not be Presbyterians without our confessing church and governmental underpinnings we have in our *Book of Order* and *Book of Confessions*. So, if you are able, come February 8th to celebrate and honor our Presbyterian faith and heritage by participating in our day of hosting the Presbytery of Middle Tennessee.

As the month of February passes, we shall have time to remember love with the sermon focus on 1 Corinthians for several Sundays and St. Valentine's Day coming up. The prolific writer and Swiss Reformed theologian Karl Barth (1886-1968), the main author of the *Barmen Declaration* in our *Book of Confessions*, commented on 1 Corinthians 13: “It is love alone that counts; it is love alone that triumphs; it is love alone that endures” (Church Dogmatics IV/2:824-40), as scholar Gordon Fee says, “All to the one end that they (the Corinthians) eagerly desire ‘gifts of the Spirit’ (14:1) for the sake of the common good (12:7).” (696, New International Commentary of the New Testament, 1 Corinthians) This love that counts is the agape love Paul writes about to the Corinthians then and Shelbyvillians now.

May we all live in and by such love,

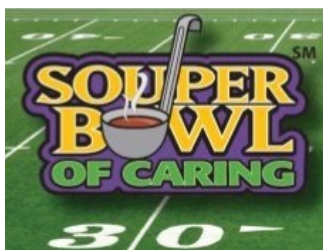
