## From the Pastor's Pen

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ!

Eastertide is the weeks following Easter Sunday up to Pentecost Sunday, June 8. The Paschal Candle is lit Easter Sunday and each Sunday following to represent and remind us of the risen Lord and the days he spent with believers after his resurrection until the celebration of Pentecost. During these Sundays, the scripture readings are about the resurrection of Jesus, the teaching of the apostles, and the ascension of Jesus to the right hand of God. The ripple effects of the Easter story and the early church provide guidance for our church today. How has the resurrection of our Lord affected you? How does the story of our Lord's victory over death inform the life of the church today? That story of doubting Thomas in John 20:19ff helps us to see who Jesus is for us today. The story of *the Acts of the Apostles* and the ministry of the Apostle Paul incredibly guide us almost 2000 years later in being faithful to our God.

This first Sunday worship in May, our church welcomes the Rev. Dr. Gary Kelly, whom we all love and enjoy as a friend of the church and an excellent preacher, to officiate at the table of our Lord Jesus. So, come to worship and share communion as the body of the risen Christ. As a reminder of part of what we do in communion, I share this poem by Ann Weems from her book Kneeling in Jerusalem titled "Holy Communion":

"Eat. Drink. Remember/ who I am./ Eat. Drink. Remember/ who I am/ so you can remember/ who you are./ Eat. Drink. Remember/ who I am/ so you can remember/ who you are/ and tell the others./ Eat. At the table of our Lord, we remember the Holy Week betrayal, suffering, crucifixion, sabbath silent grief, and empty tomb resurrection of our Lord Jesus. We remember the old, old story of Jesus and His love for each of us and all the world. Now our charge is to go to tell others of our holy communion so that *all God's children* can live together in this holy communion with God.

May the hope and joy of Eastertide dwell with you all,





