

It will take me the whole month of January to make sure I get the year right – 2022. Worship will begin the year back at the beginning where there were God and the Word. The Gospel could begin no earlier. The Prologue of John (1:1-18) then says that the Word set up His dwelling among humanity. In other words, "we are being told that the flesh of Jesus Christ is the new localization of God's presence on earth," Dr. Raymond Brown writes, "and that Jesus is the replacement of the ancient Tabernacle." (Anchor Bible Commentary, 33) In the deep darkness of our world and the ongoing exile from normalcy in the global pandemic, "we have seen a great light" (Isaiah 9:2) and are called to make room for God, who has revealed God's self in Jesus. I believe to make room for God is the call to be like Jesus in his ministry by practicing hospitality to both God and those who bear the image of God, which I understand to be every human being. As I ended the sermon last Sunday, "We gather every Christmas Eve so that Jesus becomes enfleshed in us, so that we become the very body of Jesus in the world. That's why we gather every Christmas Eve so that Jesus may become enfleshed in us. That's what Christmas means: we become the very body of Jesus. That's what happens this night before Christmas." We, the Church, become the very body of Christ so that Jesus also may become enfleshed in all humanity.

In January, three new elders will be ordained and installed, and an elder and a trustee will be installed. A couple sermons, drawn from Paul's first letter to Corinth, will focus on using our spiritual gifts and being the body of Christ. Each of us may want to reflect on the spiritual gifts God has given us and what part of the body of Christ we are or are gifted to be: hand, eye, mouth, ear, feet, etc. All humanity is called to be a part of the body of Christ. The body of Christ has plenty of room. For the New Year, as God has made room for you and me at the Table of our Lord, let us make room for everyone at the Lord's Table.

In 2022, may all God's children see the Light of Jesus shining more brightly upon them each day and find an open seat at the Table of our Lord in First Presbyterian Church, Shelbyville, Tennessee.






