


The Gospel of Luke will be our Sunday school classes and my preaching focus in worship for February. Luke tells the story of Jesus from his perspective and for his own purposes to communicate with his particular community the good news. If you can compare Luke's readings with their parallel readings in the other Synoptic Gospels Matthew and Mark, you will see differences in the way the story is told. For instance, the first Sunday in February's reading is Luke 5:1-11. It took Luke over four chapters to get to the call of the first disciples: Peter, John, and James. In the Gospel of Mark, four disciples, Peter's brother Andrew is missing in Luke 5, were called by the end of the first twenty verses! Don't let the differences bother you too much because the gospel witnesses remember the story differently and tell the story for the necessary purposes of their communities. I believe that is why we have four canonical gospels telling the story of Jesus and His love to help us stand in the shoes of both the storytellers and the communities listening. So, in the month of February, come to Sunday school and worship on Sunday to try on some new shoes and see what God is saying both to you and to our church today.

Know that it is not too late to join either one of the Sunday small groups. One adult class meets in the fellowship hall, which is closer to the donuts and coffee, and is studying the "Feasting on the Word" curriculum. The two children's classes meet upstairs to study the same Scripture as the adult class. The youth, who each Sunday are similarly studying the same Scripture, meet downstairs on "the porch." The second adult class is the young adult class, which is meeting the "Young Adult" classroom under the sanctuary, and is studying "The Shack." Come join us in study, worship, and fellowship!




# **Update on Cub Scouts**
