

Happy Easter, First Prez!

Easter is coming! However, before we arrive at Easter Sunday to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus, we must walk with Jesus through Holy Week and journey to His crucifixion and His death. Together, let us walk with Jesus to share the Last Supper on Maundy Thursday and through the gathering darkness of his suffering and death on Good Friday/Tenebrae.

It is impossible to appreciate the magnitude of the Resurrection, unless we go with Jesus into the dark depths of His death with him. The Easter joy is terribly thin without experiencing the deep sorrow and dark despair of the Son of God his last week in Jerusalem. I cannot understand with my feeble, finite human mind the love that God the Father has for created humanity. That great love of the Father we know most clearly in the sacrificial death of Jesus and his new life resurrection to life eternal for the world. The workings of his death and resurrection are the mystery of the Father's love for us and the world. Come walk with our Lord Jesus through Holy Week.

At Presbyterian College, our little Christians in Action (CIA, actually sponsored by the Baptist Student Union at Presbyterian College!) sang many praise songs as we gathered. One song stands out: "Have You Seen Jesus My Lord? He's here in plain view." As Easter is coming, I have been thinking about that song and how we think about God. Since we sing our theology, our hymns and anthems are so important to our faith and worship.

"Have you seen Jesus my Lord?" is the background question that Mary at the tomb and in her witness to the disciples posed. Mary saw the risen Lord at the empty tomb! (John 20) It is the question that faces all of us on Easter Sunday: "Have you seen Jesus my Lord?"

I do believe Jesus is here in plain view! I saw Jesus in my home church ministers like Dr. Don Warters, in my teachers from elementary school to seminary, in loving church members in Dublin, Georgia, and in the churches I have served. I see Jesus all around me in our community and church. I see Jesus in those who share in the soup kitchen ministry. I have seen Jesus my Lord in those who prepare the communion for worship and wash the communion ware after worship. I turn around in worship and see the choir and see Jesus my Lord. I see Jesus my Lord on Wednesday nights in those gathered to serve and the children who sing and do missions. I see Jesus in the family who comes knocking at our church door and who need welcome and support. I see Jesus my Lord in the ones who open and close our church doors on Sundays and during the week.

I suspect you have seen Jesus your Lord, too, in your life? Have you seen the Lord?

The candle holders will represent our participation in the death of Christ, as a representation of humanity's standing with the crowd who shouted: "*Crucify, crucify him*"! (Luke 23: 21)

## SERVICE OF TENEBRAE (Good Friday @ 7:00 p.m.)

A **Service of Tenebrae** will be observed at First Presbyterian, following an ancient Christian tradition that dates to medieval times.

Tenebrae, Latin for "shadows" or "darkness", will move our congregation through the Passion story of Holy Week to Christ's crucifixion, death, and burial ---- and from a lighted Sanctuary into the shadows of candlelight and then into darkness. In this Service, we remember these somber events and join Christians who, throughout the centuries, have observed Tenebrae.

#### Let us join together, as one heart and voice:

The Service will be marked by hymns, Scripture readings, and the extinguishing of candles. A noise (or "*strepitus*") toward the end of the Service will mark the death of Christ.

Pastor Jim asks the Congregation *to leave in silence*. Those who wish to remain in the Sanctuary for prayer are encouraged to do so.




#### Women of the Church Salad Supper


