My friends,

In worship over the Summer, we have been conversing with the Apostle Paul and the Galatian churches about what it means to be a Christian in the early church and today: do you have to be circumcised *and* baptized? Do we keep the law or are we free from the law in Jesus? During July our focus will remain on Paul; however, we will overhear a different conversation with another church, this time the Colossae church. What prompted Paul's letter to a church that he did not start? How may their conversation affect us today? From reading the letter to the Colossians, you will see that the major concern Paul had was the Colossae church's understanding of who Jesus is, or Christology.

Colossae in New Testament days was a cosmopolitan city where a number of different cultures and religions encountered one another. The Hellenistic culture affected the Colossae church so much that the Christians there adopted false teachings influenced by "wisdom teaching...from the mystery cults", "astrological speculation", and the local "Phrygian nature of worship." (p. 82, Ralph Martin, Ephesians, Colossians, and Philemon, Interpretation)

It seems that they taught that Jesus was seen as one of a number of intermediaries in a long chain of them to reach the "remote and inaccessible" God. The false teachers appeared to teach that Jesus was not human either. Jesus only seemed to be human. Paul addressed the "Colossian heresy" in this syncretic religious environment with high theology through the doctrine of Christology. So, in his letter Paul defined who Jesus is, the unique Son of God, both fully divine and fully human, and not created (1:15-19), and he also wrote about the reconciling work accomplished by Jesus' death on the cross (1:20-23). (ibid, p. 83) So, come to worship in-person and/or virtually and listen in on the theological discussion between Paul and the Colossians.

Another Summer event that will enrich your Christian life is Vacation Bible School. If you would like to get involved in assisting with the shops, drama, refreshments, decorating, supper, etc., then please call the church office and sign up. You are welcome to drop in any VBS evening for supper at 5 p.m. and also to share table fellowship in Jerusalem. Since most of us will not make the pilgrimage to Jerusalem, First Presbyterian Church is bringing Jerusalem to you. A huge thank you to everyone who is bringing Jerusalem to us the week of July 17-21!

Christian Education Director.**

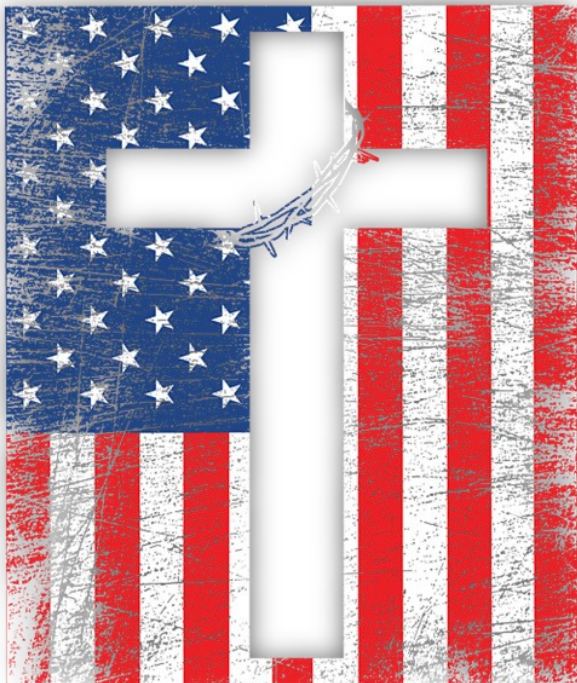

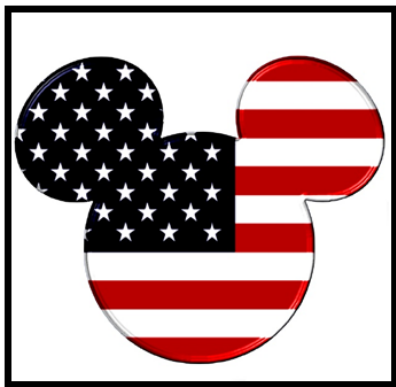
