This week at Vacation Bible School the children and teachers, among many other interesting things, learned about the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus went the night of Passover and was betrayed by Judas to the crowd of chief priests, scribes, elders, soldiers, and temple police with their lanterns, torches, swords, and clubs. (John 18:2-3; Mark 14:43) After a wonderful supper prepared by our marvelous fellowship leaders, the “tribes of Israel” Dan, Benjamin, Judah, Reuben, and Levi gathered for the opening celebration every night.

All week the teachers taught the children about Jesus and his love for them by his life, teaching, death, and resurrection. The teachers and many of the helpers and other leaders dressed in the clothes of the New Testament Bible times. The children visited the marketplace to make pottery, create dreidels, weave mats and baskets, eat delicious snacks, and craft harps. “Javelins” were thrown on the playground. Stories told, songs sung, and each night ended with a child volunteer who prayer in the front of the temple.

The children, tribe leaders (teachers), dinner hosts, directors, marketplace crafters and café chef, rabbi, recreation leaders, celebration and audiovisual leaders, registrars, actors, and “utility” helpers/actors, all worked and played together to make a week of fun, learning, and nurture in our faith in Jesus Christ. Everyone learned that Jesus is King, showed God’s love, loves us, died for us, and lives. Thank you all for such a blessed, enriching, and fun week of VBS at First Presbyterian of Shelbyville.

## Preparation for Worship (Read before service for quiet meditation):

In talking about prayer, Glenn Clark in I Will Lift Up Mine Eyes commented on prayer and then quoted Mount Rushmore National Memorial sculptor Gutzon Borglum: "Always natural, always relaxed! I do not like to see men work too hard at their prayers. Beware lest the zeal of thy house shall eat thee up. When one strains and labors over his dream, he is too often carving ivory and not polishing horn. Don't cut too deeply, don't carve too hard, don't paint the picture too much yourself. Get still awhile, and let God paint it through you. Wrote Gutzon Borglum, 'When I carve a statue, it is very simple. I merely cut away the pieces that don't belong there and the statue itself presently comes into view. It was there all the time.'"
