Our closing hymn this Sunday is the time honored African American spiritual, *I've Got Peace Like a River*. There are three verses in this hymn and in each a different thing is compared to a river. I've got *peace* like a river. I've got *love* like a river. I've got *joy* like a river.

During the slavery era of our national history, African Americans were prohibited from learning fundamentals that we take for granted like reading and writing. Slave owners also regularly prohibited slaves from organizing Christian worship. Plantation owners might hire white preachers to conduct worship for their slaves, however, the sermons generally promoted a subservience and obedience which benefitted plantation culture.

Simultaneously, an invisible church developed and grew among slaves. People were called to worship events through spoken code phrases and when they gathered, worshippers sang spirituals that also had double meanings. A spiritual might appear to speak to salvation in Christ, but the hidden message had to do with liberation from slavery and oppression.

Surely Jesus, God in Christ, brings peace and Jesus brings love and Jesus brings joy. And just as surely God has brought redemption from oppressive regimes and social structures. This Sunday's sermon will explore this matter in Luke's gospel and in the Old Testament. We will also sing the spiritual and rejoice.
