# Weekly Newsletter September 1, 2019



We Presbyterians only observe two sacraments: baptism and the Lord's Supper. Both involve the Body of Christ and both incorporate us into the living body of Christ in the world.

In his work, *The Cost of Discipleship*, Dietrich Bonhoeffer wrote that because baptism and the Lord's Supper flow from the "true humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ" the church takes visible form through them. These are bodily encounters with Jesus, through which we become "partakers in the fellowship and communion," the koinonia, of His body.

That means that we are not merely a group of distinct individuals who voluntarily show up on Sunday mornings because we like church or assert Christian slogans. It is much, much more. We are a group that has been claimed by Christ, saved by Christ, incorporated into Christ, and are the body of Christ in the world.

Bonhoeffer says that the gift of the sacraments is the gift of the body of Christ in the church. It is by *receiving* the body of Christ that we *become* the visible body of Christ.

So as you come to church this Sunday, please do not come simply as one who professes the Lordship of Christ over your life. Come with a deeper purpose. Come as one who is part of the very body of Christ. Then we will not just be a church but a holy community, truly the visible church.
