The author of a recent article in the online edition of *The Atlantic*, Derek Thompson, noted how America has lost its religiosity over the past three decades. After describing causes of this trend, Thompson spoke about the social consequences. He claimed that many people who decry the sins of organized religion don't consider how that same religion is a buffer against social angst.

He marked that religion is a "bundle" that includes things like community and social identity and a life routine and a way to find meaning and purpose. Moreover, the author said that folks who reject religion end up in a dissatisfying, piecemeal search for these things in social media or work or politics or other places.

Thompson was right. That search for meaning in one place and identity in another or one source for community and another source for a sense of purpose fragments us as human beings so that when anxiety builds in life we end up looking for a source of strength and wholeness in the same way that we might desperately hunt for a lost set of keys.

Of course the key aspect of religion that makes it a deep resource for all these important things is faith. That's faith as in confidence or reliance or trust. The concept of faith is too often limited to the idea of obedience. A lot of people are obedient to a lot of things and still do not have any transcendent thing of power in which to put their trust.

What is your faith like? Do you have enough of it? Is its source adequate when times are tough? Is it a connection to something larger than yourself? Does it comfort you in the dark? Does it help you see beyond your present circumstances?

Come to church and let's talk about it.
