This Sunday we will install new Elders as the Session class of 2022. We also recognize a new Trustee, Pat Thomas. Trustees are not installed the way Elders are but their role is certainly as vital.

Elders are elected to the Session for three year terms and, as I note the "graduation date" of the new Session class, I particularly think how 2022 seems like light years from now. However, we know that the next three years will be an important time in the life of the church. With numerous demographic shifts going on in the culture of society and Christian churches, there are decisions to be made about the direction of this congregation that require thoughtful, spiritual leadership from the incoming Session class through the duration of their term. So tell your Session what you expect and then give them your support as they discern how to adapt to a changing world while holding onto unchanging scripture.

This Sunday is Epiphany. This is the day that we celebrate the manifestation of Christ Jesus to the gentiles, specifically the three wise men from the east of Israel. The star led them across time and space to find the baby Jesus and when they found Him, the promises of God were immediately available to people far beyond the geographical and religious borders of Hebrew society.

So at Epiphany we might consider two things. *First*, that we as a congregation and our body of Ruling Elders in the Session might all receive a divine epiphany. It should be among our greatest joys that God would manifest to us some previously unconsidered divine truth and wisdom. *Second*, we should remember that God is a mystery. The minute we think we have God figured out, we realize how much we have underestimated His reach, His love, and His grace.

Our God is constantly doing new things through us and through people we might not ever think of as God's people.
