I hope that this Lent season has brought you some inspiration from God's Spirit in the small spaces of life.

Sometimes we don't notice this presence. Sometimes God is the one we call on or think about only when things are going badly for us or when we feel particularly blessed. But what about during the small spaces of regular, daily life?

Many spiritual philosophers and gurus, both religious and humanist, advise us to "tune in" to some divine spirit. There is a certain mindfulness of spiritual presence that might be brought on by fasting or deep meditative prayer. Neither of these may be your thing, but I urge you to make some attempt during Lent to be spiritually mindful of the presence of God in the small spaces of your life.

This Sunday in worship, we'll be looking at God as our help and sustenance during the journeys of our lives. We will do this through the story of Abraham's call by God and Psalm 121. One aspect of our reliance on God that comes out in this scripture is our fear in life: everything from complete desperation to mild anxiety in tense situations. Fear is a fundamental facet of the human condition and just attempting some disciplined attempt to not fear may not be enough. We should pray about it. So this Sunday please write down your fear on a slip of paper and put them in the basket which will be provided and, as a community, we will pray over this collection of fears.
