Dear Friends,

I pray this weekly communication finds you and your loved ones well. With the cases of COVID-19 infections on the rise that is a tall order these days.

Your session met this past Monday evening. One of the things we discussed were the COVID-19 protocols we have in place here at the church. Presently, we are not going to make any significant changes to those protocols.

We have put up extra signage around the church. These notifications remind folks entering the church we require people to wear masks and observe the other protocols such as social distancing, handwashing, and refraining from contact with one another.

We have also placed hand sanitizer, paper towels and disinfectant spray throughout the church building for people to use, as necessary.

We have suspended our in-person Wednesday and Sunday evening gatherings with our children and youth until after Thanksgiving. We will stay in contact with them virtually but with Thanksgiving just around the corner we would be taking a break anyway. We will reassess where we are in early December.

At this time, we have not suspended the outside groups that use our church facilities. They are aware of our protocols and appear to be abiding by them.

The news regarding vaccines is encouraging. There is a light at the end of the tunnel, and it does not appear to be an oncoming train but an end to this dark nightmare. However, it will still be many, many months before an effective vaccine becomes a vaccination. Now is not the time to succumb to COVID fatigue, though it's hard not to. Hunker down a few more months folks. We have made it this far we can hold out a little longer. I know. I'm tired of it too. You have my sympathies.
